What to bring to Nursery

We advise that all children bring spare clothes and wellies to nursery as they will spend time outdoors in all weathers. We have outdoor suits that will be washed regularly.

We also advise that children bring a hat or cap for sunny days. It is best to apply sun cream prior to starting, however we can do this at nursery and will apply again throughout the day.

Treat Fund

The treat fund is a donation of £2 per week that can be paid weekly, monthly or termly.

This money helps us pay for all the extra things like parties, fun days and other fun experiences.

Lunches

All children are entitled to free lunches

To promote independence, we will allow the children to choose what they would like from the lunch menu (If you would prefer to choose for them, let the staff know)

Fees
