CAR PARK/GATES



Our school car park can be a very busy place and in order to keep all of our pupils safe, we kindly ask that parents <u>do not park or drop off in the school car park</u> between 8.30 and 9.30am and 2.45 and 3.15pm unless any exceptional arrangements have been made specifically with the Head Teacher. We have a number of pupils from P1-P7 being dropped off at school or collected by taxis and minibuses during these times and we need to ensure that the car park is kept as clear as possible to allow them to be escorted safely to and from the playground and school entrance.

To ensure the safety of all of our pupils during the school day the gates at the Villafield and Teviot Avenue are locked during school hours from 9.15am - 11.45am and from 1.15pm - 2.45pm. Access to the school and nurseries at any other times will still be available from the main gate on Lendale Lane. We would kindly ask all visitors to the school to close over these gates at any other times to keep our school grounds as safe as possible.



We would also ask that you share the above information with any family members or friends who are involved with transport to and from school.
