Please note that P4-7 Mainstream and Gaelic Medium primaries come together for their parties. Primary 1 to 5 children can bring in their party clothes on their party day and change at lunchtime.

Tickets for our school show 'Pirates of the Curry Bean,' involving pupils from P3 to P7 and C4 to C7, will cost £5.00 and will be sold initially on a first-come, first-served, two per family basis. Due to fire regulations we can only offer 200 tickets for each performance. Order forms for tickets will be sent out shortly. Money raised from the show tickets goes towards funding the Christmas Parties for every class as well as the Ceilidh band for the P6 and P7 Christmas Ceilidh. P7 costumes will be arranged in school and Miss Mitchell will be in touch for any other P7 requirements but for P3-6 and C4-6 pupils we would ask that they bring in clothes to dress as a Pirate for the show for Tuesday 3rd December. Please do not go to any cost and buy anything new - the outfit could be a plain coloured or striped t-shirt, bandana or scarf for head, old trousers and then an optional longer scarf tied round waist/waistcoat if pupils already have one. Please contact the school if you do not have any of these items at home and we will do our best to help.
