1. Minutes	Previous minutes circulated via e-mail	Mrs Doherty to upload to school website.
2. Financial	Balance of account £4601.73 Grant Applications - ED community grant - Wellbeing Workshop -school has booked 2 classes already, so has an idea of cost. If we wanted whole school, 6-7 visits we would ideally apply for about £3,000 of funding. Joanna to look into drafting a proposal for end of Nov We have applied a £2000 grant from Miller Homes for playground equipment to replace the wooden boat. Successful applicates will hear by end of Nov. We also applied for £500 towards costs of school disco	
	from River Island via Parentkind, winners announced 7th Oct, so probably not successful. Asda cashpot for Schools is going strong, with a great	

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	uptake. We're averaging £10 a day, so hopeful to earn close to £1000. We will find out the final balance by 31 December and receive funds by April '25	
3. Feedback from Welcome Disco	Not enough sets of ear defenders for children who requested them. Is it possible to split the discos and hold 3 events instead of 2 or can we look at purchasing additional ear defenders?	Include on poster that if a child requires ear defenders they should bring theirs with them. Generally most children who can't cope with the noise of the disco will have their own pair for other events.
	Lots of parents stayed at the disco to watch clogging exits and space, some were taking photos which is no permitted.	Advise that unless a parent is a volunteer at the event they are not permitted to stay. No photos to be taken at the event will be included on the next poster too.
	First disco was well attended with numbers of 120 at the first disco and 125 at the second. Approximate profit of £600.
