LEARNING THIS TERM

The children will all be busy learning about 'Our Working World' this term and will have opportunities to develop, demonstrate and apply skills as part of learning about the wider world of work.

This term, as part of the Health and Wellbeing Curriculum, children will be also learning about Relationships and Sexual Health and Parenthood (RSHP). Please see attached parent information leaflets which explain the content covered as part of this aspect of the curriculum at Early Level (Nursery to P1), First Level (P2 to P4) and Second Level (P5 to P7). WEATHER - BE PREPARED!

As we move closer to Summer, please ensure that your child comes to school prepared for any potentially warmer and sunnier weather ahead. We would advise that includes making sure that they are 'sun-safe' with their own sunscreen to re-apply during the day, a sun-hat/head covering and a water bottle to keep hydrated.
