<p>Homework Survey</p>	<p>*See PowerPoint for full details 171 families, 72% responded highest, high across all classes 74 families felt homework was ‘just right’ 19% too much, 10 families too little. 85% liked less homework in December and June 4.39 stars on Homework comms on Seesaw. 4.25 on Diary 4.35 on homework out on Mon and back on Fri Timing, flexibility, load, communication quality – staff and pupils to be consulted.</p>
<p>Traffic</p>	<p>Email from Sustran transport officer Meadowburn, along with other schools, has been approved for phase two. Statutory consultation – SPT, emergency services etc for 4 weeks</p>
