LEARNING THIS TERM

The children will all be busy learning about 'Our Natural/Outdoor World' this term through and continuing to develop this through a PEBL (Pupil Enquiry Based Learning) approach for P3-7. The key Social Studies skills that will be developed through this topic are:

People, Place and the Environment

Early Level - Investigate Nature and living things and develop an awareness of the need to care for the environment.

Investigate nature by caring for the environment.

First Level - Compare and contrast physical features of my local area with a different natural environment.

Evaluate how these features impact on the variety of living things.

Second Level - Investigate causes of a natural disaster and evaluate the impact on both people and landscape.

Explore ways in which humans interact with the planet and the effect this has.



WEATHER - BE PREPARED!

As we move closer to Summer, please ensure that your child comes to school prepared for any potentially warmer and sunnier weather ahead. We would advise that includes making sure that they are 'sun-safe' with their own sunscreen to re-apply during the day, a sun-hat/head covering and a water bottle to keep hydrated.
