Mathematics

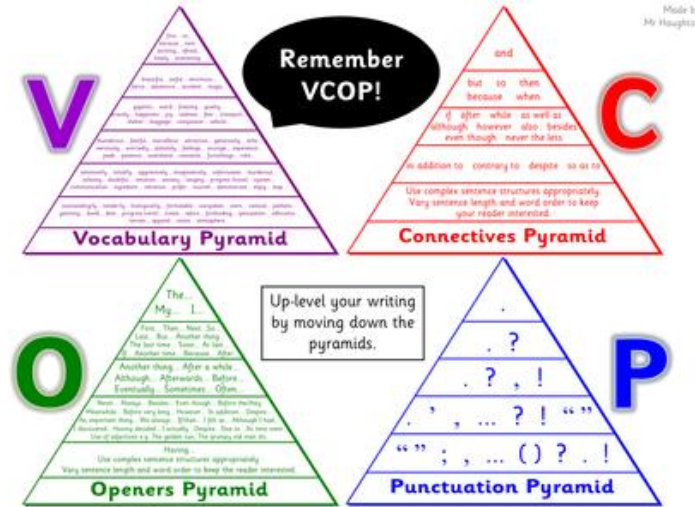
- Pupils enjoy active learning in many aspects of the curriculum, working individually or in groups.

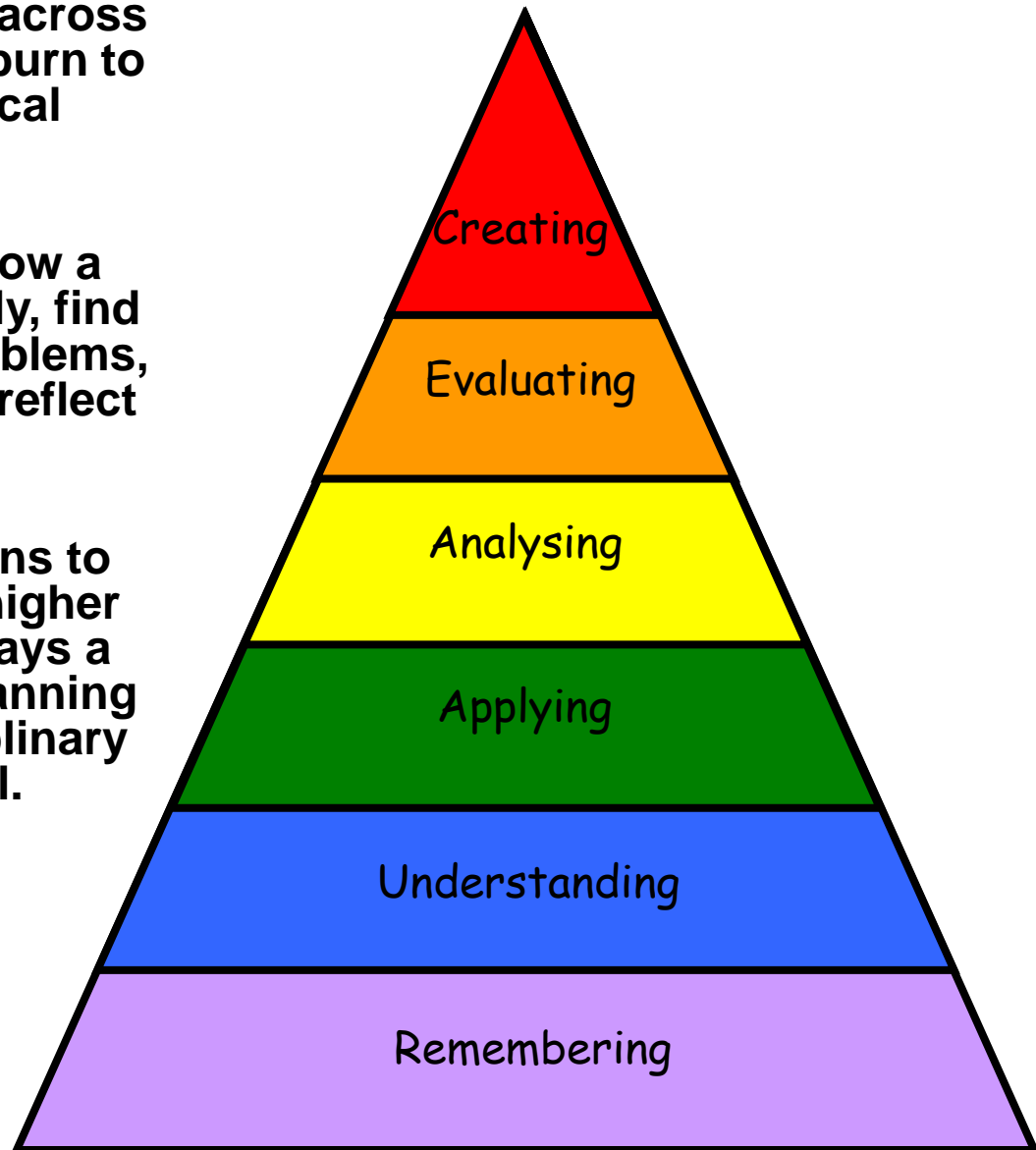
Pupils take responsibility for their own reading sessions. Each week a different child within the group has a designated role.

Blooms

Blooms taxonomy is used across the curriculum in Meadowburn to develop children's critical thinking skills.

Critical thinking skills allow a child to think independently, find and fix mistakes, solve problems, evaluate alternatives, and reflect on their own beliefs.

It is used as part of lessons to encourage and promote higher order thinking skills. It plays a fundamental role in the planning and delivery of interdisciplinary learning in the school.



Outdoor Learning

Pupils in Clas 6/7 will be participating in Outdoor Learning as and when appropriate. Permission slips must be completed for each child and parents will be informed when pupils will be leaving the school grounds.

Appropriate risk assessments will be in place and parent volunteers are requested.
