If the children lose golden time they will be given the chance to earn this back throughout the week.




Gentle Reminders






We use VCOP to encourage children to look at their writing and to improve their progress.


How can they make their writing better by looking at including more complex Vocabulary, Connectives, Openers and Punctuation.





Reading:

• Spelling:

This will be sent home on a Monday. It will be a mixture of phonics and common words, usually alternated from week to week.

• Maths:

Consolidation of concepts taught in school. This could be a worksheet or an Active Maths based activity.

Please hand in any urgent letters to us or via your child in the morning. These can be placed in their 'letter folder'


