# Homework



Homework will be issued on a Monday and should be handed in on a **Friday**.

- **Reading:**  
Storyworld books will come home every week. Literacy Links will also be sent home to encourage reading for enjoyment.
- **Spelling:**  
This will be sent home on a Monday. It will be a mixture of phonics and common words, usually alternated from week to week.
- **Maths:**  
Consolidation of concepts taught in school. This could be a worksheet or an Active Maths based activity.

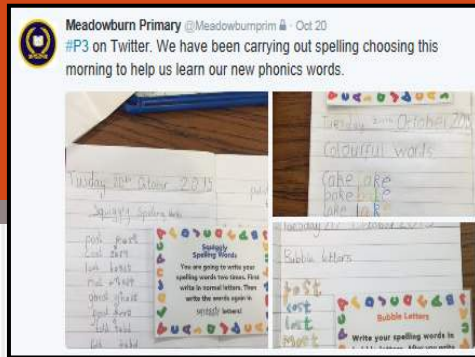
