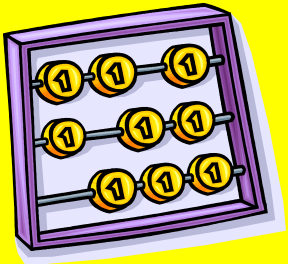

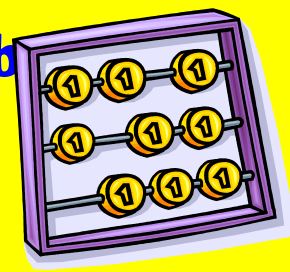

# Maths

**Fractions, decimals and percentages:**

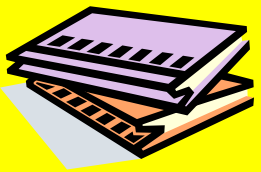

Pupils take responsibility for their own reading sessions. Each week a different child within the group has a designated role.

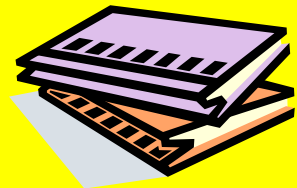
The format is very structured, with the children following a carefully worded script.

Please check e-mails for any communication from school.

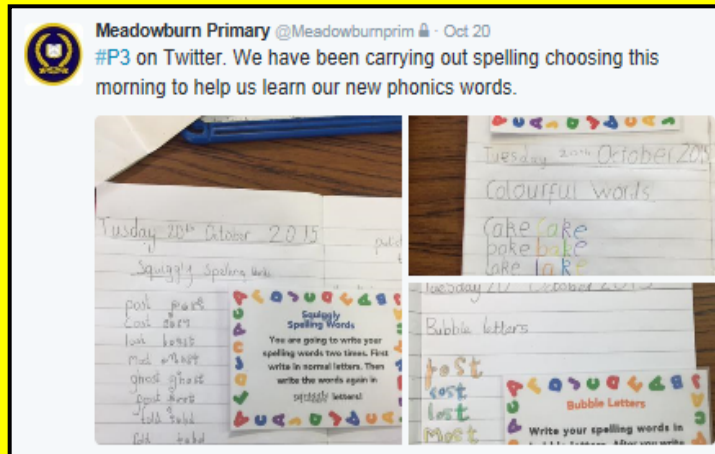
Gym days-**Tuesday and Thursday**
