It has been another successful year for fundraising. The main fundraising events for us this year was the Christmas fair and calendar with a profit of £1745.38 and £840 and a combined total of £2585.38.

The main expenditure was for both fairs and the Jute and canvas bags. We are currently sitting at a loss for the bags -£742.78 but these can be sold at any time through the year. I do believe that we will make a profit on these.

The PTA will start the next year with a balance of £8655.24 and there are already a number of large items that we have agreed to pay for. These include swimming lessons, new school sound system and the busses for the school trips.
